Call for Abstracts

The Indiana Public Health Association is now accepting virtual presentation abstracts for its 2023 Annual Meeting & Conference, “MOMENTUM”. The event is on **Tuesday, April 18th at 10 AM – 3:30 PM ET**.

Abstracts may be submitted by undergraduate and graduate students, academic faculty and staff, and public health practitioners. Abstracts are welcome on a range of topics (listed below), though authors are encouraged to submit abstracts that align with the event purpose to maintain and build upon the momentum of Indiana’s public health progress and foster continued support, partnerships, and excitement around creating a healthier Indiana.

Presentations will be virtual via Zoom Events and limited to 10-15 minutes. Audience Q&A will be facilitated following all presentations. If your abstract is accepted, you will be required to participate in your assigned session time in the afternoon on Tuesday, April 18th.

You may not present more than one abstract during the virtual conference, but you may be a co-author with colleagues on other presentations. You do not have to be a member of IPHA to submit an abstract; however, if your abstract is accepted, the presenting author will be required to join IPHA and must register for the conference. Scholarships are available.

The final deadline for abstract submission is **Friday, March 17th at 11:59 PM ET.**
