

Call for Presentation Proposals

2025 Annual Conference & Awards, Mobilizing for the Moment

The Indiana Public Health Association (IPHA) is accepting presentation proposals for the 2025 Annual Conference & Awards on Wednesday, October 22 at the Ivy Tech Conference Center in Indianapolis, Indiana. This year's theme, *Mobilizing for the Moment*, calls us – public health professionals, advocates, and partners – to harness our collective strength and rise to today's challenges with determination, intention, and hope.

We are seeking proposals for 45-minute presentations, workshops, panel discussions, or collective learning formats that explore how we can come together to amplify impact and drive meaningful change when it matters most to us and, more importantly, to the communities we serve. *Note: The presenter can choose how to allocate time during the 45-minute session. Please plan to include time for audience Q&A*.

Proposals may be submitted by any individual or group working in public health, including undergraduate and graduate students, academic faculty and staff, and public health practitioners. Proposals are welcome on a range of topics, though authors are encouraged to submit proposals that align with the theme and topic areas listed below.

Proposals should align with one or more of the following topic areas:

- Policy & advocacy
- Workforce development & support
- Leadership
- Communications
- Social determinants of health
- Public health service delivery

If your proposal is accepted, the presenting author(s) will be required to purchase a ticket to attend the conference. Presenters will receive a discounted registration rate. Event scholarships are available here.
